NOTE: Total surface area of all structures shall not exceed 40% coverage of the unit/site area. No more than 50% of the lot may be covered by structures, plus "non-absorbent" materials such as concrete, asphalt, etc. Pavers are not considered non-absorbent material in this calculation. The unit owner is responsible to obtain all applicable permits from the County, in addition to this CH permit.

A **cable/utilities location search/confirmation** must be conducted prior to doing work in the easement area (5' on all sides) of your lot. This includes removing trees, planting trees, grinding stumps, placing pavers, etc. Failure to conduct a cable/utilities location will result in the unit owner paying for the repair of damages caused to these cables/utilities.
